



What is The EnCORE Project?

THE ENCORE PROJECT IS A CORE COMMUNITY SCHOOL POST-HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAM DESIGNED TO SUPPORT HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATES TO DISCOVER AND DEVELOP THEIR PURPOSE AND PASSIONS, AS WELL AS TRANSLATE THESE THINGS INTO PRACTICAL APPLICATIONS FOR THE FUTURE. PARTICIPANTS WILL CHOOSE THE TRACK THAT BEST FITS THEIR GOALS: COLLEGE-FOCUSED OR VOCATIONAL-FOCUSED. THE COLLEGE-FOCUSED STUDENTS WILL RECEIVE 1-ON-1 ASSISTANCE WITH COLLEGE CLASSWORK, ORGANIZATION, EXTRA SKILL-RELATED INSTRUCTION, AND HELP NAVIGATING THE FIRST-YEAR COLLEGE EXPERIENCE. STUDENTS WITH THE VOCATIONAL FOCUS WILL BE INTRODUCED TO A VARIETY OF CAREER SECTORS THROUGH A SERIES OF APPRENTICESHIPS AND GIVEN PERSONAL ASSISTANCE WITH DEVELOPING A PORTFOLIO AND PLAN FOR FUTURE EMPLOYMENT OR EDUCATION. THROUGHOUT THIS ONE-YEAR PROGRAM, PARTICIPANTS IN BOTH TRACKS WILL LEARN THE FINANCIAL, SOCIAL, AND PRACTICAL LIFE SKILLS THAT ARE CRUCIAL FOR INDEPENDENT LIVING. PARTICIPANTS WILL ALSO BE PROVIDED OPPORTUNITIES FOR SELF-EXPLORATION AND PERSPECTIVE BUILDING THROUGH MENTORSHIPS, COMMUNITY SERVICE OPPORTUNITIES, AND TRAVEL EXPERIENCES. STUDENT GOALS WILL BE SET AND EVALUATED THROUGHOUT THE PROGRAM IN COLLABORATION WITH PARENTS, STAFF, AND PARTICIPANTS. THE ENCORE PROJECT IS HEADQUARTERED AT CORE COMMUNITY FARM @ LAKEVIEW IN SCENIC WOODSTOCK, GA.



Track 1: College Focus

Track 1 is designed for high school graduates who are committed to attending a post-secondary institution. During the course of the year, students will receive course-related academic help, skill-related instruction, and learn how to navigate the digital and physical resources of their respective post-secondary institutions. In addition to receiving a peer mentor, each participant will work closely with career coaches and academic support staff to develop a comprehensive life plan that goes beyond career goals and focuses on personal development. Students are required to fulfill the Core Requirements in order to receive a certificate of completion.

Outcomes:

- Admission to next year of college
- Attainment of state ID/ Driver's License
- 100 Hours of Writing Workshop
- An understanding of the specific resources at their PSI
- EnCORE Project - Certificate of Completion

***Participants must have been admitted to a partner college or university before the beginning of the program.**



Track 2: Vocation Focus

Track 2 is for participants that are committed to entering the workforce. We work with participants to tailor a one-year career program that allows them to gain practical work experience and insight into career fields of interest. Our vocational coaches will help participants identify apprenticeships they want to pursue, coach them through the interview process, and help them operate successfully in different work environments. Participants are required to fulfill the Core Requirements to receive a certificate of completion.

Outcomes:

- **Completion of 400 hours of apprenticeship hours**
- **Attainment of ID/Drivers license**
- **Checking and Savings Account**
- **Resume**
- **Industry Connections**
- **Personalized Career Plan**
- **Job Placement or Tech School Admission**
- **Vocation Specific Tools**
- **EnCORE Project - Certificate of Completion**



CORE Requirements

The Core Requirements of the EnCORE Project are structured to assist students with the development of the qualities and skills that lead to more productive and fulfilling lives. These requirements are designed to develop students' abilities to live independently, serve their community, and create lifestyles that are physically/mentally/emotionally healthy. These requirements are met by students completing workshops and educational hours. The Program Coordinator will work closely with participants and families to determine their specific needs and adjust or accommodate these requirements as needed.
